## The Laodicean Apostacy In Todays Local Churches

'Behold, I stand at the door and knock, if any man hear my voice and open the door, I will come into him, and will sup with him and he with me. To him that overcometh, will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in His throne'. – Revelation 3:20,21

The Lord Jesus Christ is by no means inside the 'Laodicean Church'. Christ does not come into the assembly; it is too late for that.. Christ's knocking is not at the door of the unregenerate heart, but at the regenerated hearts, to cause them to repent and come out as witnesses against the apostate church. In these two verses the Lord Jesus Christ was no longer addressing the church. He was appealing to individual lost sheep within the Laodicean church.

'The doom of the Laodicean Church was sealed'. The Lord Jesus Christ is standing outside, at the door knocking for admittance into his own church.

The majority preach a Jesus, a gospel, and a spirit that does not originate from the Bible. The Apostle Paul feared that the minds of the Corinthians would be corrupted by such false preaching. Although the door of the Laodicean Church was closed to the Lord Jesus Christ of Holy Scripture, it was '**not'** closed to heresy and deception.

'For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you and for them at Laodicea, and for as many as have not seen my face in the flesh... and this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words... beware lest any man spoil you with philosophy and vaine deceit after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ...' - Colossians 2:1,4,8

During His first advent, the Lord Jesus Christ was calling people out of Judaism (religion). Before the rapture of the saints, there will be an apostasy in organized Christendom. We are presently in the 'last of the last days'. Human philosophy seeks to reduce the fundamentals of Christianity from it's own principles.

Man is depraved and cannot and will not come to the Lord Jesus Christ, unless He the sinner is first called in a true conversion experience, because of regeneration.

Arminian doctrine teaches that any man can come to the Lord Jesus Christ, when he cannot do so. An unregenerate heart is incapable of making a decision towards Christ. Truly obedient spirit filled christians would not be involved in organized religion during this Laodicean apostacy. Majority of the local churches today are characterized by Laodicean apostacy today! Organized Denominationalism, is alreadyfalling short of the glory of God.

In the early New Testament Church, there were no Baptists, Methodists, Roman Catholics, Presbyterians, Lutherans, etc. There should be no proper name given to the the assembly of Christ, while in time, as the Lord is still building it and it is unfinished.
