# David Berg - William Branham Historical Research

David Brandt Berg was the <u>central figure</u> of the <u>Children of God cult</u>, <u>aka</u>, the "Jesus Freaks", more recently known as <u>The Family</u>, International. As <u>Children of God</u>, Berg's <u>cult</u> became notorious in Southern <u>California</u> for <u>recruiting new members</u> through <u>sex</u>. The group advertised themselves as "Happy Hookers for <u>Jesus"</u>, and stirred up controversy among Christians who disagreed with their recruiting <u>strategy</u> as well as prostitutes who were losing business to the movement. According to Berg, <u>William Branham prophesied</u> over his <u>ministry</u> during the <u>Latter Rain</u> version of Branham's <u>stage persona</u>, which led to his establishment of the <u>Children of God</u>. It should come as no surprise that the <u>Children of God</u> first began as an apocalyptic, anti-Establishment <u>gospel</u>. Interestingly, Berg lived in Louisville, Kentucky, in <u>1947</u> — just across the river from Branham's hometown of Jeffersonville, Indiana.

I had to get out & I was forced to go back to <u>college</u>--I didn't even want to but I had to--living on \$25 a week, which was a lot of <u>money</u> in those days, in a way, but barely supported us, living in somebody else's borrowed little 14-foot trailer with a <u>family</u> of a <u>wife</u> & three children! It was pretty rough, hand-to-mouth & living by faith, but it was the making of things, because it was from there we went to build a <u>church</u> in <u>Arizona</u> & had all those experiences & Branham <u>prophesied</u> over me & it was from there I got out of the <u>church</u> entirely, broke loose, & joined Fred Jordan. He was another rebel, he'd broken with the <u>churches</u> & was really preaching the Truth, the facts. [3]

## - David Berg

David Berg was a <u>Christian and Missionary Alliance</u> minister and <u>evangelist</u> who toured with his <u>mother</u>, Virginia Brandt Berg, during the early years of his <u>ministry</u>. [4] While she preached, Berg sang <u>gospel</u> songs and used pictures to teach the <u>Bible</u>, [5] or more specifically, <u>doomsday</u> by the <u>atomic bomb</u>. [6] In the early 1950s, Berg pastored the Community <u>church</u> in <u>Valley</u> Farms, which was affiliated with the C&MA. [7] In 1951, Berg was accused of <u>sexual misconduct</u> and kicked out of the <u>church</u>. [8]

Shortly after being ousted from the <u>church</u> in 1951, Berg attended a meeting with <u>William Branham</u>. At the end of the meeting, Berg received a <u>prophetic</u> blessing on his <u>ministry</u> from <u>William Branham</u>, which Berg referred to as the "*Philadelphia <u>Prophecy</u>*". After that <u>prophecy</u>, Berg became disenchanted with denominational <u>Christianity</u> and began to change his <u>ministry</u>. [9] Empowered with Branham's <u>Latter Rain</u> blessing, Berg began preaching in <u>Latter Rain churches</u>. In November 1951, for example, Berg held a series of nightly lectures at <u>Leroy Kopp's Calvary Temple</u> in <u>Los Angeles</u>[10] — the <u>church</u> that helped promote <u>William Branham's ministry</u> with the film <u>Twentieth Century Prophet</u>.

Throughout his life, Berg insisted that <u>William Branham</u> and the <u>Latter Rain evangelists</u> won thousands of souls to <u>Christ</u>. He insisted that Branham had a powerful "word of knowledge", [11] and tied current events to Branham's alleged <u>prophecies</u>. When President Bill Clinton was elected, for example, Berg claimed that <u>Hillary Clinton</u> was the fulfillment of Branham's 1933 Prophecies. [12][13]

The Churchianity system spends so much time & <u>money</u> getting ready, on preparation, that they never get the job done! One little hick <u>evangelist</u> like Tommy Hicks or <u>William Branham</u> who had no <u>education</u> & who butchered the <u>King's</u> English, could go out there & win hundreds of thousands to the Lord, heal thousands & accomplish more than these guys with all of their <u>education</u>, & these denominations with all their <u>church</u> buildings! It's pitiful!<sup>[14]</sup> - David Berg

David Berg studied <u>William Branham's sermons</u>, and described segments from them to <u>The Family International cult</u> members in his nearly 3,000 "Mo [<u>Moses</u>] Letters". In <u>the way</u> in which Branham is fondly described by Berg, it is clear that the letters were reminding his <u>cult</u> members of statements previously made about Branham. In some cases, he referenced his December 1979 <u>letter</u>, <u>Millions of Miles of Miracles</u>, which gave <u>cult</u> members an account of the <u>Life Story</u> used by Branham's <u>stage persona</u>. Other times, Berg used Branham's personal <u>childhood</u> stories as examples for his own <u>doctrine</u>. Idel[17] He often reflected on those conversations, as well as Branham's tragic life. Berg claimed that "the Lord sent him across my path". Image impact on his life. Berg claimed that "the Lord sent him across my path".

HE THREW HIS ARMS AROUND ME & HUGGED ME & kissed me & said, "Don't worry, son, don't worry. Everything's going to be all right." Then he quoted that same little verse from the Philadelphia <u>Prophecy</u>. (See <u>Letter No.695</u>.) He said, 52. "THE LORD IS GOING TO OPEN UNTO YOU A GREAT DOOR THAT NO MAN CAN CLOSE. He's going to close all these other doors that no man can open. Don't even try to open them. The Lord's going to open unto you a great door, greater than anything you ever dreamed of!--A door that no man can close!"[20]

#### - David Berg

Berg was convinced that Branham's "halo photograph" was real, and that the photograph captured an angelic being rather than the lighting system of the Sam Houston Coliseum. Like Jim Jones of Peoples Temple, [21] Berg was a convert to Branham's UFO theology, and Berg taught his converts that UFOs were actually angels as Branham claimed. [22] Berg instructed converts to "believe that halo represents at least your Guardian Angel" and often used Branham's alleged halo as an example for making his point. [24] When he described angels, Berg used one of the varying descriptions of the physical form of an angel used by Branham's stage persona. [25][26]

Berg was especially fond of Branham's sermon <u>"Future Home of the Heavenly Bridegroom"</u> which was plagiarized from Clarence Larken. He wanted his "*mansion in the city"* to be Branham-style. When Berg described heaven, he used Branham's descriptions of heaven

for members of his <u>cult</u> — right down to the <u>animals</u> in heaven. [27]

AS FAR AS I'M CONCERNED, IF YOU WANT MY MANSION IN THE CITY, YOU'RE WELCOME TO IT! I'LL TAKE THE COUNTRY!--Ha! Remember William Branham's dream about Heaven?--He had a little cottage out in the country & he had his old rocking chair just like he used to have. He was a country boy, you know, very country!--In fact, he really talked like an old country hick, which he was. But he was a mighty power, a man of God, & he did a great work for the Lord & even had a part in mine. So I'm sure he's working for me even now & probably enjoying that little cottage out in the country. [28]

### David Berg

From a doctrinal standpoint, Berg lifted several ideas from Branham when creating his <u>cult</u>. Like Branham, [29] Berg was opposed to using the word <u>"Trinity"</u>, saying, "*You can't find that word in the <u>Bible"</u>. [30]*. Also like Branham, Berg taught that God had a <u>Trinity</u> and Satan <u>copied</u> it. [32] Berg believed Braham's <u>end-of-days prophecy</u> concerning <u>Communist Russia</u> and the impending race <u>war</u> that Branham had predicted. [33][34] Both Berg [35] and Branham [36] spoke strongly against <u>Martin Luther King</u> and the <u>Civil Rights</u> movement because of the <u>Prophecy</u>. Berg included Branham's <u>1933 prophecies</u> of <u>Rome</u> and the world <u>council of churches</u> in his own <u>end-of-days doctrine</u>. [37] Berg continued Branham's themes of <u>British Israelism</u> and <u>Christian Identity</u>, though he was far more plainly spoken against people with <u>black</u> skin than Branham's constrained public <u>persona</u>. [38][39] While Branham used subtle <u>antisemitism</u> with doctrinal <u>teaching</u> such as "the <u>gospel</u> was not for the <u>Jews"</u> as Branham claimed God was a segregationalist, [40] Berg openly stated that he was "an anti-Semite because God is! Yes I'm a racist because God is!"

AMERICANS, AS <u>William Branham</u> SAW IN HIS <u>VISION</u>, WILL BE THE MOST POPULAR <u>SLAVES</u> IN THE WORLD & sold at high prices. In the most powerful countries, the most intelligent countries, the most civilised countries, the leaders of the <u>Communist</u> World such as <u>Russia</u>, etc., Americans will be their prize <u>SLAVES</u> because of their high level of intelligence & <u>education</u> & technical skills & <u>music</u> & [DELETED] <u>beauty</u>. [DELETED] The dances they're learning now are going to be <u>tools</u> of their trade in that day. The [EDITED: "other social"] skills they're learning now are going to be <u>tools</u> of their trade in that day to <u>help</u> them survive & have favour of their masters & win their hearts & their souls as well, PG! "Hear ye the true words of thy father![42]

At the same time, Berg eventually rejected some of Branham's core <u>doctrine</u>. Berg believed that the <u>Seven churches</u> of Asia Minor mentioned in the <u>Book of Revelation</u> were literal <u>churches</u>, [43] while Branham taught the dispensationalist views of <u>Cyrus Scofield</u>, <u>Clarence Larkin</u>, and <u>Charles Taze Russell</u>. Because of this deviation, Berg also rejected the notion of a pre-<u>tribulation rapture</u>. [44] He did, however, hold to Branham's <u>prediction</u> of atomic destruction.

In <u>1962</u>, David Berg made headlines in Miami/Dade <u>schools</u> for his position against <u>teaching evolution</u> in <u>schools</u>. Berg argued that the textbook presented <u>evolution</u> as an established fact rather than theory, and began rallying <u>support</u> from the <u>evangelical</u> community to remove the textbooks (and <u>teaching</u> of <u>evolution</u>) from the <u>schools</u>. [45] Berg rallied the <u>support</u> of the <u>Full Gospel Businessmen's</u> Association International (the group that sponsored <u>William Branham</u>), and nineteen <u>FGBMI</u> ministers came to the <u>school</u> board meeting to protest. [46]

Just as "Message" splinter group leader Jim Jones of Peoples Temple migrated to South America in the 1970s, the Children of God staged a mass exodus from the United States in the 70s. [47] While this could be attributed to Branham's 1977 Doomsday prophecy concerning the United States, [48] Berg and the Children of God cult were also facing opposition by cult deprogrammers and New York's charity-fraud bureau. [49]
