ISLAM'S PAGAN ORIGINS

Tradition	Pagan Religions Pre-Islam	Modern Islam
Symbols	Hubal was the Arabian moon god worshiped at the Ka'aba. The crescent moon was Hubal's symbol	Crescent moon and star are universal symbol of Islam
God name	Al-ilah was the title for the Arabian pagan high-god	Allah
Object of worship	Arabian pagan gods were worshipped in the form of kissing rectangular stones or rocks	Worship the rectangular Ka'aba stone in Mecca
Prayer	Pagans prior to Islam would pray five times per day towards Mecca	Pray 5 times per day toward Mecca
Ablution	Zoroastrians are expected to recite their prayers (five times a day) having first cleansed themselves by washing	Wudu is the Islamic procedure for washing parts of the body using water, typically in preparation for formal prayers
Fasting during Muharram	Muhammad's pagan tribe, the Quraish, fasted on the 10 th of Muharram . (first month of lunar calendar)	Optional fasting during Muharram. (first month of lunar calendar)
Practice of Ihram	Ihram was originally a pagan requirement for worshipping idols during pre-Islamic times.	Ihram is a state a Muslim enters into for his pilgrimage to Mecca. It involves a series of procedures like ritual washing, wearing 'Ihram garments', etc.
Circle around a object	Islamic pagans used do it to please the moon god Hubal the 360 deities and Al-ilah. (This tradition is found in ancient Egypt as well)	In the Islamic ritual of Tawaf, Muslims go around the Kabaa 7 times

Pre-Islamic Pagan worship of the MYTHICAL goddess AL-ILAT at Mecca

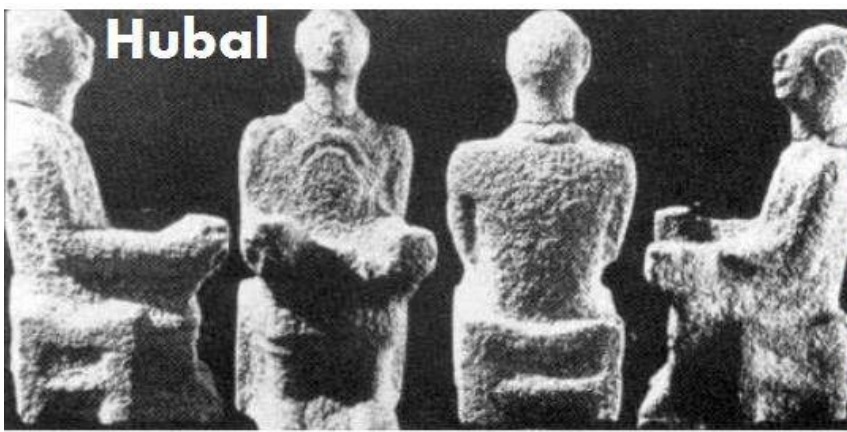


Modern Day Islamic worship of the god ALLAH at Mecca



Islam originates from earlier Arabian pagan moon worship.

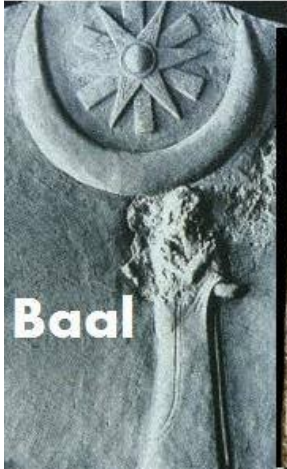




Hubal

Hubal the chief idol of Mecca is linked to Baal also known as Tammuz

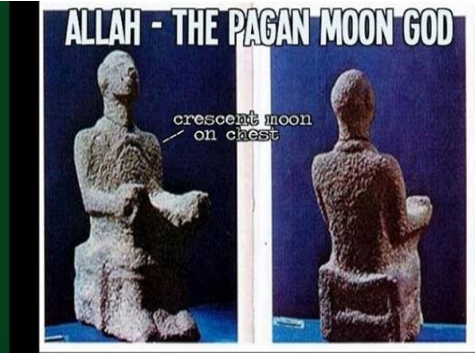
The moon-god from all four sides. Note the crescent moon carved on his chest.



Baal



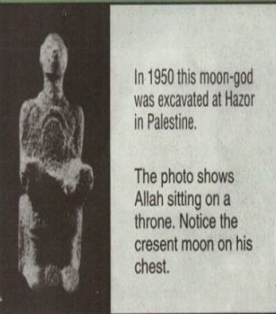
The Crescent Moon shown above the alter in this seal is the symbol of the chief Babylonian god "Sin," which was also the chief god worshiped in ancient Arabia at the time of Mohammed. The Crescent Moon still symbolizes the Arab-Islam moon-god re-named Allah.



Islam is nothing more than a revival of the ancient Moon-god worship.



The crescent moon symbol is everywhere in Islam.



In 1950 this moon-god was excavated at Hazor in Palestine.

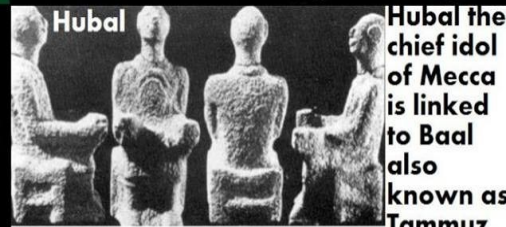
