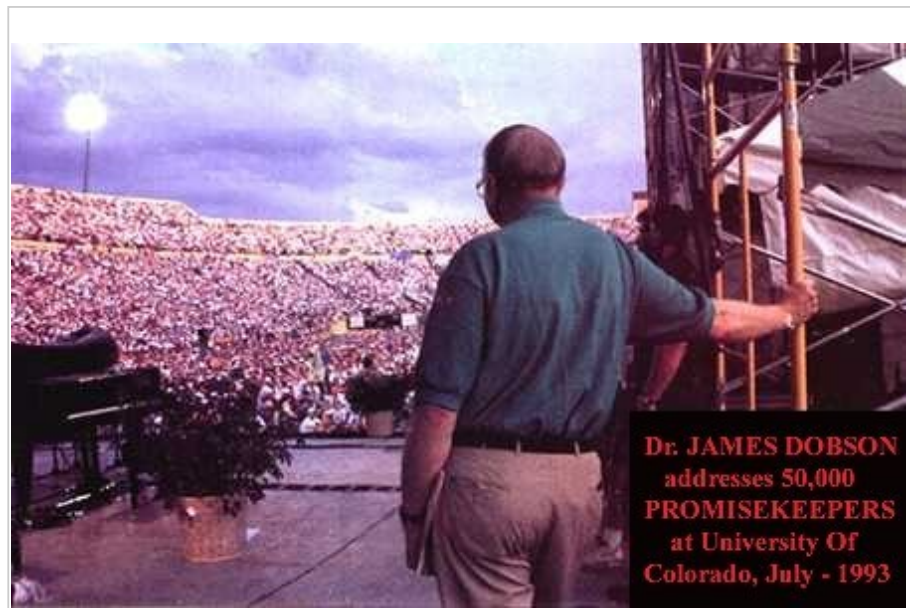


Dr. James Dobson

"Our reason for existence is to help preserve the institution of the family."

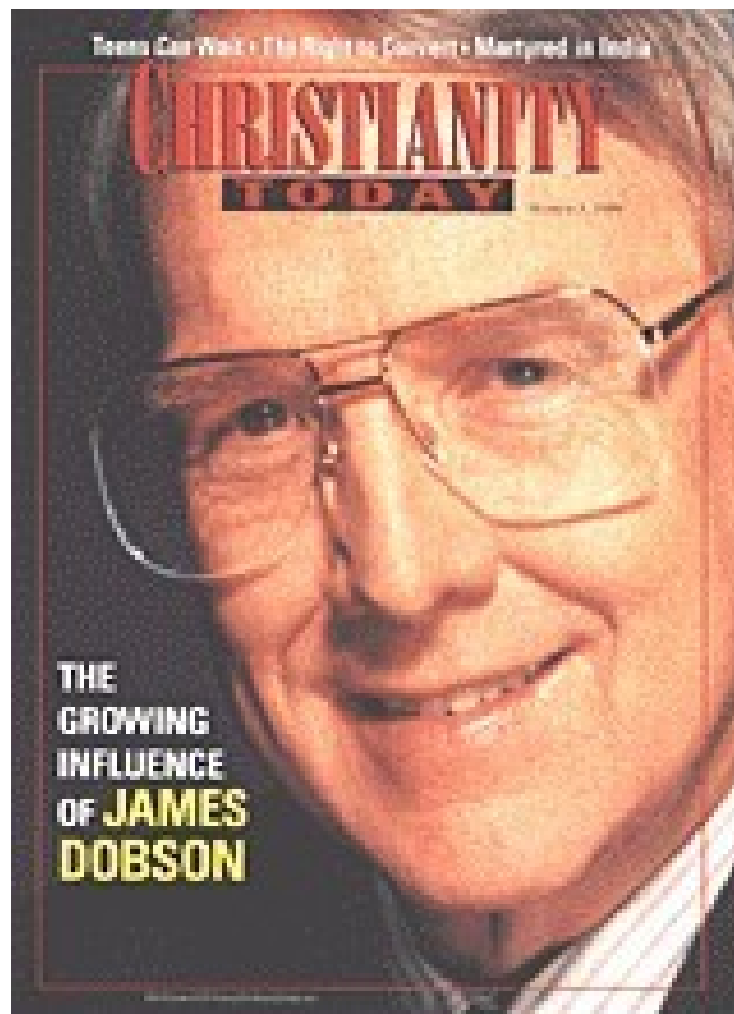
