In Luke 24:4 and Acts 1:10 the greek word 'andres' is used which is translated to 'men'. A general first time reading of these two verses would lead one to conclude angels or angelic beings are meant, but then why is the word 'andres' used instead of 'angelos' or 'messenger'?
